NOTE

In order to streamline Medical Care in referred City Clinics /Hospitals for students, the following is advised:

- 1. For any advanced treatment, patient (student of IIT Kanpur) will need a referral from Health Centre. The patient should go to the doctor/hospital being referred to by the Medical Officer on Duty. Taking referral is a must when the reimbursement is claimed by the student.
- 2. The patient should not leave the referred hospital without taking the 'Medical Certificate', Discharge Slip and Reports of the investigations done.
- 3. In case the patient takes a 'leave against medical advice (LAMA)', the patient must be discharged ONLY by the parents or an authorised local guardian. No post-discharge services will be provided by the Health Centre, IIT Kanpur under these circumstances.
- 4. In case of LAMA, the student WILL NOT be treated/admitted in the Health Centre.
- 5. In case of LAMA, no reimbursements will be entertained against that request.
- 6. The use of ambulance is for 'medical emergency' only. The need of using the same will be decided by the on-duty doctor of the IIT Kanpur Health Centre.
- 7. For any non-critical condition, the ambulance may not be provided to the patients as they are reserved for any critical conditions that may arise for other student.
- 8. For referral to another doctor/hospital/clinic/centre for treatment as out-door patient (OPD), no ambulance will be provided. The patient can hire a taxi/auto on their own.
