C. MESS DUES AS PER ACTUAL (To be paid to the Hall of Residence)

All students whose application for conversion to dual degree programme has been approved, will be treated as M.Tech students for the purpose of fee calculations. If the application for conversion is in process, they will be considered at par with BT/BS Students.

(a) Students belonging to SC/ST/PH categories are given 100% waiver on the Tuition Fee.

(b) The following courses offered in the Summer Term 2021 are given 100% waiver on the Tuition Fee: TA201P, ESO205P, ME222P, ME231P, CHE492A, CHM343A/CHM344A & PHY441A.

(c) Tuition fee for modular course will be half of that for regular course.

(d) SC/ST student is not charged the hostel seat rent if parent's /guardian's income is less than ₹6 lakhs.

Day scholars are not charged water charges & mess establishment charges. However, Hostel seat rent has to be paid.

* For 2016 to 2021 Batch BT/BS Students:

MEB - The most economically backward BT/BS students (whose family income is less than ₹1 lakh per annum) will get full remission of the tuition fee.

OEB - Other economically backward BT/BS students (whose family income is between ₹1 lakh to ₹5 lakhs per annum) will get remission of 2/3rd of the tuition fee.
