Assignment 31

<u>Please watch Lesson 31 before attempting this assignment.</u>

We will take two seeds out of 16 shown on the slide "**Major Forms of Sentences**": seventh in the first column (active) and fourth in the second (passive), namely

- (A) "[Wh..] + have/has / had / will have + we/I/he + [not] + given ...?" and
 - (B) "We/I/He + are/am/is / were/was + [not] + being + given"

for expansion. Construct your own sentences (36 for seed A and 12 for seed B) to illustrate all the cases that may arise out of these two seeds. The main verbs (replacing 'give' in the examples on the slide) to be used in your sentences are given in the tables below.

Try to use, to the extent possible, subjects other than living beings, avoiding (whenever possible) even tangible material entities, in place of "we" (standing for a general plural subject) and "he" (standing for a general singular subject) in the seed. [Only "I" as a subject in its place is irreplaceable.] See two examples below.

Plural subject:

<u>Severe Conditions of the peak Indian summer</u> made the Swiss patient sick.

Singular subject:

Will the leadership of a member of the royal family succeed in uniting the people?
