**Physiotherapy Arrangements at Health Center
(w.e.f. Thursday , the 8th April, 2010)**

With reference to intimation received from the Medical Officer In-charge Health Center, all concerned are requested to note the new Physiotherapy Arrangements at Health Center w.e.f. Thursday, the 8th April, 2010 as per details hereunder:

Physiotherapy Room

The Physiotherapy services shall now be provided in a much larger and newly furnished A/C Room located on the rear side of the Health Center, having the following new features.

1. This room has more space, with proper waiting area segregated from the therapy area.
2. The larger space shall make the activity more convenient for the service-provider and more comfortable for the users. More than one patient shall be able to take the therapy simultaneously without a feel of overcrowding.
3. The vehicle carrying the patient brought to HC, for Physiotherapy, can now be driven right up to the Door-Step of the physiotherapy Room, so as to reduce the need for the patient to walk much to the place of service.
4. A separate segregated Cabin for Physiotherapy for Lady Patients has also been created in this room.


The Timings

The timings for Physiotherapy Services have been extended and shall now be provided for three hours every evening from 5.00 PM to 8.00 PM.

The Physiotherapist

Mr. Sanjai Bhagat, Physiotherapist, will provide the services w.e.f. Thursday, the 8th April, 2010. Mr. Bhagat is a Post Graduate in Physiotherapy (MPT) and has sufficient experience and exposure to the profession. He has also been a teaching Faculty in some Institutes and is listed as a member of Physiotherapy Associations in India and Abroad. Whenever advised by the treating medical/surgical specialist and/or Institute Medical Officer/Advisor, Physiotherapy services can be availed by the eligible members of IITK Community at the Health Center.
