Clarification on Fees Remission on Family Income terms.

The economically backward students, whose gross family* income for the previous financial year is not more than Rs. 5,00,000 per annum (without any standard deduction) are eligible to apply for remissions of fees. family income includes the salaries (from all sources) + Income from business/ medical practice / legal practice / Engineering consultancy + agriculture + land properties + income from Investment in bank or Post office + Income from share / debentures + Income from other sources all the sum of these incomes shall be of Family income and income of Self (Student) if any shall also be the part of Family income.

The Income Proof documents should be the "Family Income certificate" for the Current Financial year duly Signed by the competent authority, authorized by the State government in the format prescribed by the Government.

OR

The copies of detailed ITR and acknowledgement for the current financial year of both the parents shall be the valid documents to get the exemption in Tuition fees or its remission along with an affidavit on Non Judicial stamp paper of Rs 20/- (as per format placed below) to be submitted along with the Income Proof.

(*) The term "Family" for this purpose includes the person, who seeks benefit of reservation, his/her parents and siblings below the age of 18 years as also his/her spouse and children below the age of 18 years.
