

## **IIT Kanpur welcomes the Y20 batch of BTech/BS Programmes for Semester 2020-21-I.**

**Congratulations** on qualifying in JEE (Advanced) – 2020 and choosing IIT Kanpur for your studies!

Due to the extraordinary circumstances arising from the COVID-19 pandemic, all instruction in the upcoming semester (2020-21-I) will be conducted in the REMOTE teaching/learning mode, and you will be required to attend classes online from your home/present place of stay. You are not required to report at the Campus for the Semester 2020-21-I.

### **Class Schedule**

Classes will begin in the second or third week of November. The academic calendar will be made available on the website of the Dean, Academic Affairs (<https://www.iitk.ac.in/doaa/>) by November 8th.

### **Registration as a New Student**

To start with, you need to fill in an online form and upload scanned copies of the original documents on the portal for 'New Student Profile'. The link will be made available on the website of the Dean, Academic Affairs (<https://www.iitk.ac.in/doaa/>) in due course of time.

Students in the GEN-EWS (Economically Weaker Sections) and OBC-NCL (OBC Non-Creamy Layer) categories are required to upload the valid category certificate in prescribed formats as detailed in the JEE (Advanced)-2020 Brochure. SC/ST/PwD applicants are required to upload the category/disability certificates in the prescribed format and valid as per rules.

The verification of the documents/certificates uploaded by you will be done against the originals on a later date when the Institute re-opens for students. The schedule for the same will be notified through email later.

### **Academic Registration**

The schedule for the Online Academic Registration will be updated on November 8, 2020. The link to the Academic Registration portal will be made available on the website of the Dean, Academic Affairs.

Further, you are required to

- a) Download and Install the required apps for attending lectures and accessing lecture materials as recommended by the instructor. Adobe Scan or similar Apps can help in scanning documents using mobile phones.
- b) Install the videoconferencing app for live interactive sessions that an instructor recommends. Most of the instructors might be using Zoom. Create a Login in Zoom using IIT Kanpur E-mail ID.
