Assignment 03

Please watch Lesson 3 and Tutorial 3 before attempting this assignment.

Part A

1. Each word family has a base sound which is equivalent to some sound in Hindi. For instance, word family "cat" has a base sound which is equivalent to a slightly more open version of \overline{v} . Similarly, word family "big" has a base sound equivalent to \overline{s} .

In the same manner, give equivalent base sounds in your CLL for the "cup", "box", "ball" and "bed" word families.

2. For each of the following word families, write two words other than those given in Lesson 3.

Word family – "bed", "big".

3. Write three words other than those given in Lesson 3, which belong to the "cup" word family, but are exceptions. (For example, put, pull, etc.)

4. All the expressions of your CLL can be expressed verbatim in English. Do you agree or disagree with this statement? Justify in 2-3 sentences.

5. After converting a sentence, word by word, from CLL to English, we need to rearrange the words to construct the correct sentence in English. Why do we need to do it?

Part B

From the internet, find a passage (approximately 15-20 sentences) in Hindi (or Bengali, Oriya, Marathi, Gujarati, Punjabi, Telugu, Tamil, Malayalam, Kannada or Urdu) for 'expression'.

At the top of your write-up, mention the title, author's name, the URL where you have taken the passage from and the page number (if the passage is a part of a larger document).

Now, take the sentences in the passage one by one and translate them into English using 'Expression' process illustrated in Lesson 3.
