## Part A

- 2. Choose two words from 'Mixed Words: 2nd List' which have the same sound pattern and make a sentence containing both.
- 3. Choose two words for each category of *parts of speech* from 'Mixed Words: 2nd List': **Noun, Adjective, Verb, Adverb**.

  Make a sentence with each one of them.
- 4. According to the lecture, simple and direct translation from English to an Indian language is not always possible and is dependent on the context. Give one such example and elaborate how the same verb form can have different senses in that language. (Refer to the slide with verb forms of 'tell'.)

- 5. According to the lecture, elaborate the difference in the use of 'I am told' and 'I have been told'. What different meanings do the two verb forms convey?
- 6. Pick up a verb from the word family 'day'. Repeat the exercise as practised in the lecture: Start with an active affirmative sentence, then convert it to passive, then to negative passive, and end with converting it to an active negative sentence. Write all the conversions in between.
- 7. Repeat the same exercise as above, but now with a noun from the word family 'law'. Choose the sentence in such a way that all conversions are possible.
- 8. Make a sentence which contains at least three words from exceptions in the 'home' word family and change its voice. Choose the sentence in such a way that all conversions are possible.
