Part A

- 1. How many objects can a verb take? Is there any verb which cannot take any object with it?
- 2. Give examples of three sentences where the verb cannot take an object.
- 3. Give examples of three sentences where the verb takes two objects.
- 4. Use a verb in two sentences as intransitive and transitive verbs. That is, in the first one, the verb sense is such that it cannot take an object; while in the second, it can take an object.
- 5. How many objects are there in the sentence: "I gave ten books to five students".
- 6. What is the difference between 'be' and 'become'?
- 7. Can any of the verbs in the list of hundred verbs take the form of any other part of speech? If yes, what other parts of speech can these verbs assume?
- 8. Make pairs of sentences with verbs from the given list with (i) one sentence in the sense of verb and another in the sense of noun, and (ii) one sentence in the sense of verb and another in the sense of adjective.
- 9. Explain LOADER technique. How is it useful while making the summary of a book?
- 10. Explain CODER technique.

Part B

Read a fresh story from the internet, which you have not read earlier. In your submission, include the following, in the given order.

- (a) Title and Author's name.
- (b) The URL, or the address of the story on the internet where you read it.
- (c) A list of items, by covering which a summary can be prepared.
- (d) A summary in 30-50 sentences, in less than 800 words. [Prepare the summary using the LOADER method illustrated in Lesson 20 with the above notes.]
