

# Assignment 21

Please watch Lesson 21 and Tutorial 21 before attempting this assignment.

## Part A

1. From the second list of a hundred verbs, list five verbs which cannot take any object.
2. From the second list of a hundred verbs, list five verbs which can take two objects. Illustrate through sentences.
3. From the second list of a hundred verbs, list five verbs which have two meanings; one as a verb and another as a noun, adjective or adverb.
4. Make five sentences using each of these verbs once as a verb and once with another meaning.
5. Use a verb in two sentences as intransitive and transitive verbs. That is, in the first one, the verb sense is such that it cannot take an object, while in the second, it can take an object.
6. Make a pair of sentences with a verb from the list with (i) one sentence in the sense of verb and another in the sense of noun. (ii) one sentence in the sense of verb and another in the sense of adjective.
7. Pick five verbs from the second list of a hundred verbs and write down their verb forms.

## Part B

Write a **brief essay** in **300-400 words** (approximately 20-25 sentences or 4-5 paragraphs), on the topic of your choice, applying the **C-O-D-E-R** strategy outlined in Lesson 20.
