Part A

1. What are 'suffixes' and what is their use?
2. How do prefixes affect words? List examples of some prefixes and the sense in which they affect words.
3. Give examples of 'phrasal verbs' derived from an original verb. Explain their meanings.
4. "We had entered and the doctor had preceded us into what was evidently his waiting room."
What type of sentence is this? Identify the subjects, verbs and the clauses in the sentence.
5. "When the Mongols approached the city, the citizens knew that the frontier outposts had failed."
Identify the different kinds of clauses in this sentence.

Part B

Pick up **5 mixed sentences** (each with at least 15 words) for analysis, possibly out of the 20 mixed sentences collected by you as part of Assignment 32, or by replenishing it by further search.

For each of them,

- a. parse the sentence, i.e. break it into its constituent parts and analyse the sentence as done in Lesson 37,
- b. work out the skeletal structure of the sentence as in the prescription of Assignment 26, and
- c. in this skeletal structure, frame a new sentence of your own.
