□ 3rd and 5th Forms of Verbs

❖ Revision of Verbs: Lists 1 and 2

❖ 3rd and 5th Forms of Verbs

➤ In most cases, the 3rd form operates as an *adjective*.

You ate **packed** food.

➤ The 5th form connecting with a *noun* or a *verb* shows its action as an *adjective* or an *adverb*, respectively.

Growing *plants* need care.

She *goes* to the doctor **taking** her sister.

Present	Past	Future
am/is/are	was/were	will be

The train is late.	The train was late.	The train will be late.	The train will not be late.	Will the train be late?	...

❑ Gerunds and Infinitives; Dummy Subjects

❖ Word Families: 'pause' & 'dual'

❖ Verb forms as adverbs and nouns

- Adverbs show the purpose and answer the questions like 'why'.
- Nouns answer the question 'what'.
- 5th form or 'to + 1st form' can operate as a noun.

We eat to stay alive.

Do you want to learn English?

Theft is shameful.

Stealing is shameful.

To steal is shameful.

❖ Dummy Subjects

- Capture the place of subjects, which may appear later in the sentence.

There is a problem.

It rained heavily last month.

There will be a war.

□ Structure 'be + 3rd form' and the Passive Voice

❖ Word Families: 'law' & 'day'

❖ List 4 of common verbs.

❖ 'be + 3rd Form'

- 'Be' and 3rd form (adjective) of a verb unite to make a composite form used in passive voice.

The actual price of the pen is charged.

The manual was written by me.

When will the guava be eaten by the bird?

- A sentence can be reframed in passive voice only if the verb is transitive and the object has been supplied in the original statement.

I know clearly. Can we reconstruct it in passive voice?
