❖ Word Families: 'boil', 'radio-lion', 'ruin', & 'medium'

Two objects

> Direct Object: Sufferer of the action.

> Indirect Object: Beneficiary of the action.

The principal gave a <u>prize</u> to <u>me</u>.

A <u>prize</u> was given to <u>me</u> by the principal.

The principal gave <u>me</u> a <u>prize</u>.

I was given a <u>prize</u> by the principal.

Special Structures

Dummy Subject	Logistic Necessity	Habitual Past
It/There/They	'has/have/had to'	'used to'

- Word Families: 'cloud-rough-four-group'

 - > forms sentences in perfect tense.
 - > expresses the present state of a completed action.

Daily	Now	Earlier	Already
I play chess.	I am playing chess.	I played chess.	I have played chess.

Phrases:

> supplies additional information about events, states, position, etc. in a sentence.
