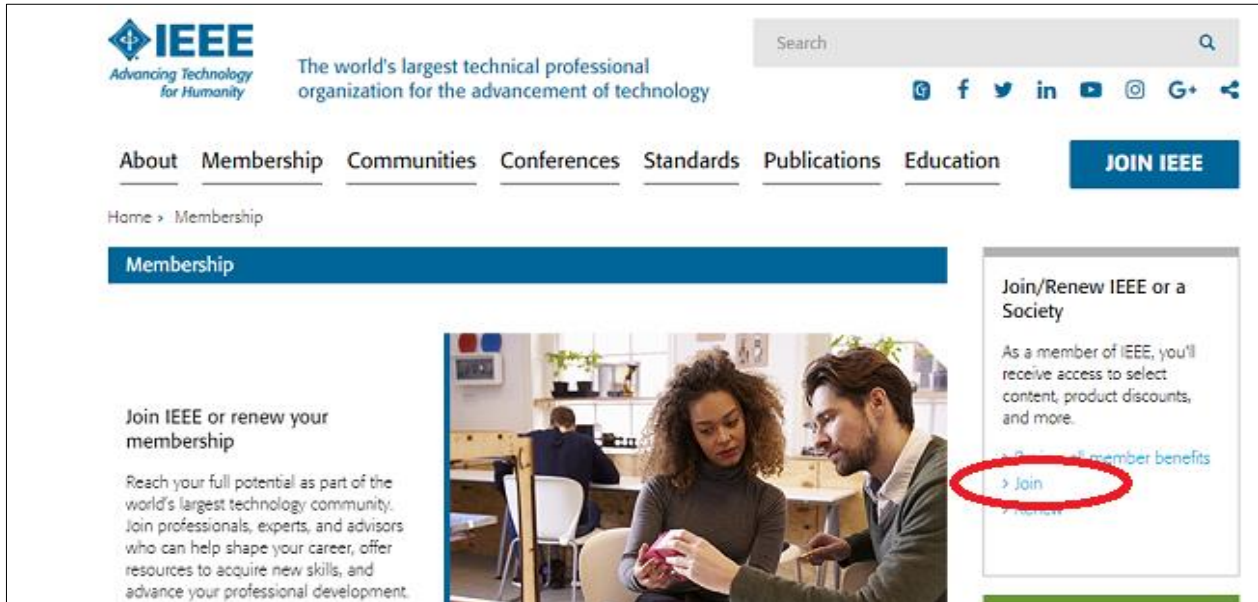


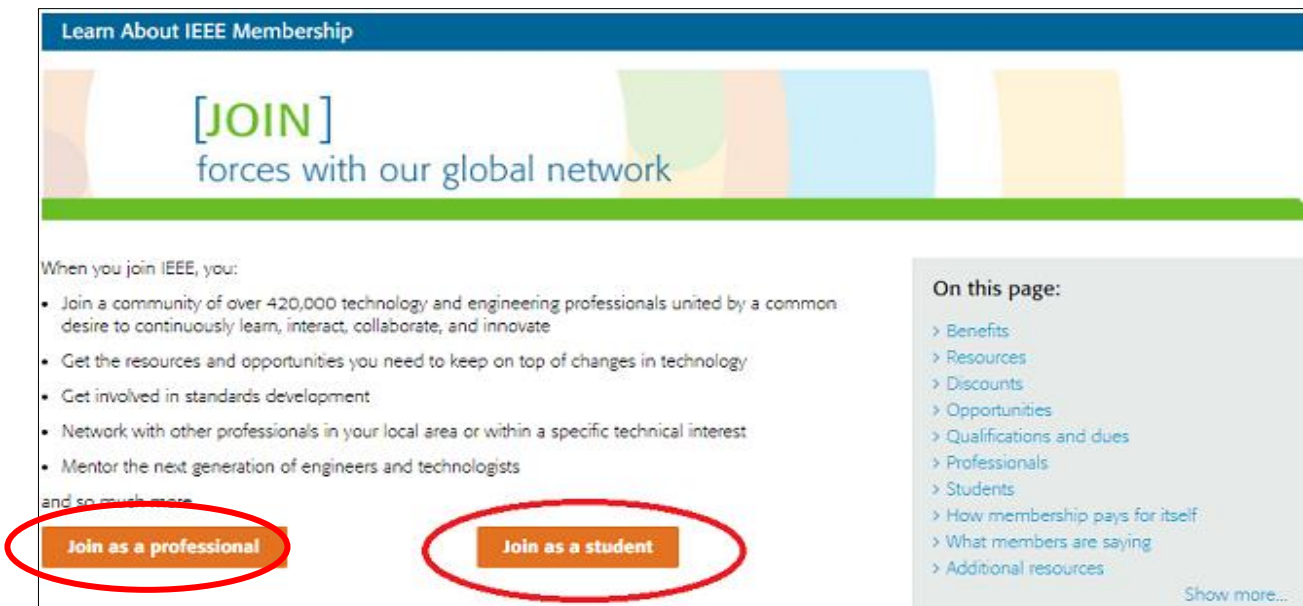
How to become an IEEE CIS Member??

Step 1: Visit the link: <https://www.ieee.org/membership/index.html>

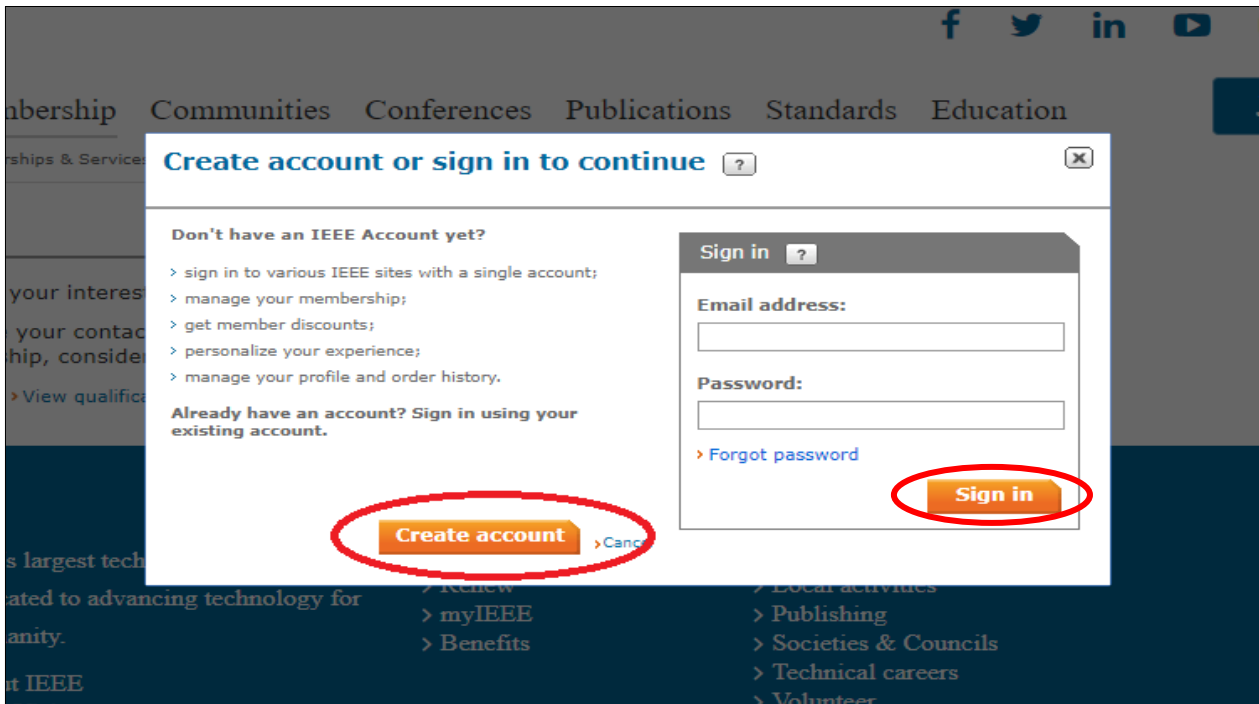


Click Join

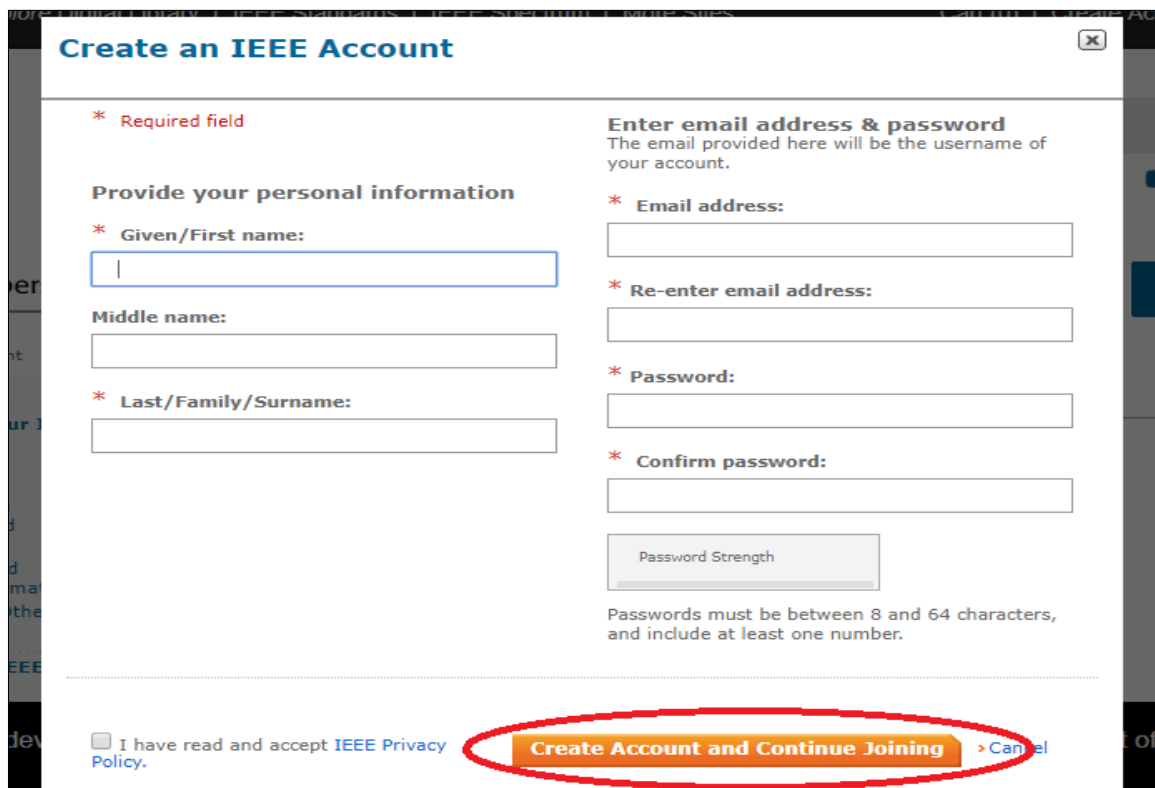
Step 2: Select an option: "Join as a student" or "Join as a professional"
