Research area: First and Second language acquisition, Language teaching and testing, Typological studies

In particular, I focus on the interface between the general cognition and language-specific syntactico-semantic patterns in the acquisition. I am also interested in similarities and differences between L1 and L2 acquisition and enhancing success levels in instructed L2 settings. As part of the latter part of this research, I also work in the areas of language teaching methodology and testing.
