

INTERVIEW SCHEDULE
AND
HOW TO BE APPROPRIATELY PREPARED FOR THE PHD INTERVIEWS?

Points to Remember:

1. Please use a well-lit and quiet room. Make sure you have a stable network connection. Make sure nobody else is present in the room during the interview.
2. Use either a white board, or a black/green board, or a white sheet attached to a board, that you can place vertically.
3. They should be placed at appropriate distance from the camera, such that what you are writing is visible (write larger if needed), as well as a good region of the white board/ the full white sheet is visible. Ensure you are also visible.
4. For white board use a marker/ for paper use sketch pen/ for black board use a white chalk to increase visibility. For white board, please use an angle such that there is no reflection from the light sources.
5. Important to check your setup beforehand. Does the mic work? Is writing on the board visible in the camera? It is necessary that you test your setup by making some video calls to your friends. Get their suggestions to improve your setups.
6. If possible, try to make a 20 seconds video recording yourself and check if all the points mentioned above are addressed.
7. Your interview will be terminated if use of any unfair means is detected or if your arrangement of appearing for interview is found not to follow the directions given above.

Common FAQs

Q1. What happens if my network gets disconnected?

Ans. Do not worry. Keep trying for 4-5 minutes. If it takes longer, then you will be contacted by DPGC over the phone/Whatsapp number you have already provided and will be advised on the next course of action.

Q2. What happens if the camera on my mobile/laptop does not work?

Ans. Try to keep a second mobile with zoom installed handy.

Q3. What if I have a nervous breakdown during the interview?

Ans. Feel free to tell the interview committee; it will not be held against you. Your interview might be postponed, and you will be contacted by the DPGC over the phone/WhatsApp number you have already provided and will be advised on the next course of action.

Q4. Do we need to prepare presentations on our MSc project/topic of interest?

Ans. Not at all. We mostly like to evaluate you on your competence at MSc level physics in general.

Q5. Can I use a tablet or any other mode of communication to write solutions to the questions asked?

Ans. No. Only a white board, or a black/green board, or a white sheet attached to a board, as mentioned above is allowed.

Q6. What topics should I prepare for the Interview?

Ans. Basic topics: Classical Mechanics, Quantum Mechanics, Electrodynamics, Mathematical Methods. Advanced topics: Statistical Mechanics, Condensed matter Physics, Atomic and Molecular Physics, Nuclear and Particle Physics.

(You may be asked to choose 2 basic topics and one Advanced topic).

Q7. Can my interview be rescheduled to another date?

Ans. No. Since this time interview is declared to be only on 19th November, we cannot take interview on any other dates. However, we can reschedule it to some other time on 19th November for emergency cases.
